The website operator takes your data protection very seriously and treats your personal data confidentially and in accordance with statutory regulations.

Access data

The website operator or page provider collects data about access to the page and saves it as "server log files". The following data is logged in this way:

- Visited website
- Exact time the site was accessed
- Amount of data sent in bytes
- Source/reference from which you accessed the page
- Browser used
- Operating system used
- IP address used



The data collected is used solely for statistical evaluations and to improve the website. However, the website operator reserves the right to subsequently check the server log files if there are concrete indications of illegal use.

Cookies

This website uses cookies. These are small text files that are stored on your terminal device. Your browser accesses these files. The use of cookies increases the user-friendliness and security of this website.

Common browsers offer the setting option to reject cookies. Note: There is no guarantee that you will be able to access all the functions of this website unrestrictedly if you choose to reject cookies.

Handling of personal data

The website operator collects, uses and passes on your personal data only if this is permitted by law or if you consent to the collection of data.

Personal data is any information that is used to identify you and which can be traced back to you, such as your name, e-mail address and telephone number.

Handling of contact data

If you contact the website operator through the contact options offered, your details will be stored so that they can be used to process and respond to your enquiry. This data will not be passed on to third parties without your consent.

Handling of comments and contributions

If you leave a contribution or comment on this website, your IP address will be saved. This is for the security of the website operator: If your text violates the law, the operator wants to be able to trace your identity.



Google Analytics

This website uses the "Google Analytics" service, which is offered by Google Inc. (1600 Amphitheatre Parkway, Mountain View, CA 94043, USA) to analyse the use of the website by users. The service uses "cookies", i.e. text files which are downloaded onto your terminal. The information collected by these cookies is usually sent to a Google server in the USA and stored there.

IP anonymisation is used on this website. The IP address of users within the member states of the EU and the European Economic Area will be truncated. By truncating the IP address, the personally-identifying component of your IP address is eliminated. As part of the contract data agreement concluded between the website operators and Google Inc., Google uses the information collected to evaluate the use of the website and website activity and to provide services related to Internet use.

You can prevent cookies from being downloaded onto your device by selecting the appropriate settings in your browser. If your browser does not allow cookies, there is no guarantee that you will be able to access all the functions of this website unrestrictedly.
